

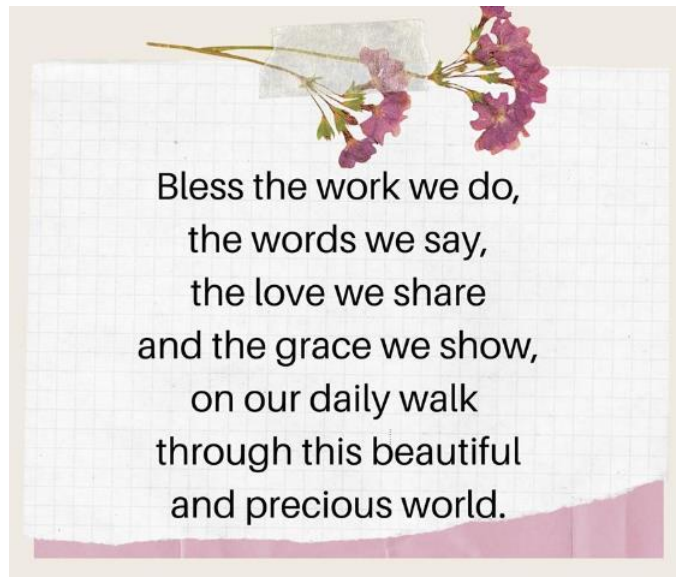


# EPCHS Student 'PD' Bulletin #8

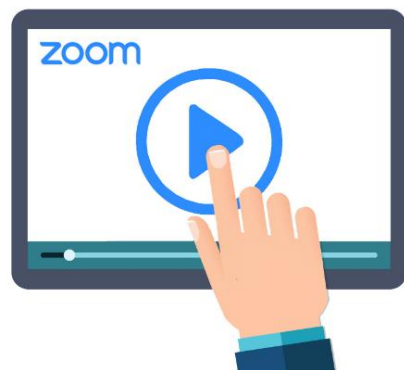


## **Year 10 – Virtual WExp @ EPCHS**
