EEF – Rapid evidence assessment on the impact of school closures the attainment gap

"The projections suggest that school closures will widen the attainment gap between disadvantaged children and their peers, likely reversing progress made to narrow the gap since 2011. The median estimate indicates that the gap would widen by 36%."

The 2019/20 PP strategy is under current evaluation and will inform the planning of the strategy for the upcoming academic year. The below areas will also be part of this plan whilst leading on trauma informed practice. The quality assurance schedule will sit alongside this also.
