


Towards the end of November, two pods like these will be installed to provide hot grab and go food within our cluster group areas. They will be a great asset to the school and we look forward to seeing them in action.

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Work experience opportunities at Airbus Aerospace



Airbus Aerospace Work Experience | Springpod

Airbus is an international reference in the aerospace sector. They design, manufacture and deliver industry-leading commercial aircraft, helicopters, military transports, satellites and launch vehicles, as well as providing data services, navigation, secure communications, urban mobility and other solutions for customers on a global scale.

During this free two week virtual work experience programme students will meet (virtually) representatives from some of the key teams within their business from space to civil aviation. They will learn about fundamental elements of Airbus's business including sustainability and manufacturing. Finally they will complete work and assignments to get an understanding of what life at Airbus is like.

The programme involves around 10 hours of activity. Students can complete the work over 2 weeks meaning they can fit it around their schedule. There are live workshops but if they are unable to attend these a recording will be added.

The programme will take place between 30/11/2020 and 13/12/2020. Students do not need to be available full time during those dates but they do need to be able to complete 10 hours worth of activity over the two weeks.

What's involved:

During this virtual work experience programme students will cover the following areas:

- Space Meet a member of Airbus' space team.
- Wing Manufacturing at Broughton Take a look at manufacturing at our Broughton base.
- Sustainability Explore the work of Airbus' sustainability team.

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- Apprenticeships at Airbus Learn about entry routes into Airbus.
- Getting hired at Airbus Everything you need to know from interviews to applications.

Eligibility

In order to take part you must be in Years 10-13 and attend a school or college in the UK. The deadline for applications is the **23rd November.** Applicants will find out if they have a place on the programme on November 25th
