This qualification is designed for learners who want an introduction to performance that includes a vocational and project-based element. The qualification will appeal to learners who wish to pursue a career in the performance sector or progress onto further study.

Term	Unit of Work	Intent
Autumn Term A	Practice Synoptic Project	During this first half term students will complete a practice of the final project – following the exam guidance given. This will prepare students for the final practical exam which will be given Late December. Theory lessons will focus on preparation for the written exam – usually late autumn term. Assessment will take place at the end of the half term through a sharing or work and discussion/reflection of the roles developed. There will be sufficient reflection time to improve work and or elicit feedback on different responses.
Autumn Term B	Theory Work. Exam	Students will focus on folder evidence in preparation for their final moderation. Theory lessons will focus on the exam (first attempt) in November. Assessment will be marking and feedback given against the examination boards guidelines. Exam will be completed. Final synoptic Project introduced. There will be an effective use of group collaboration allowing discussion and debates.
Spring Term A	SYNOPTIC PROJECT	Students will complete the final project, this must be done independently – as the teacher becomes the examiner. Theory lessons will focus on completing folder evidence that supports the practical project. Assessment will be covered in all lessons through observations which are recorded for exam evidence. There is opportunities to build on and extend previous learning.
Spring	EXAM	Theory lessons will focus on Folder evidence and preparation for the exam (second attempt).

Term B	SYNOPTIC PROJECT SHOWCASE	Assessment will focus on the final showcase performance – which must include solo and group work. Evidence will be both practical and written (recorded evidence) There will be an effective use of group collaboration allowing discussions and debates.
Summer Term A	FOLDER WORK	In this term students will complete any outstanding evidence work needed to complete the course. A moderator will visit the centre and give feedback based on the evidence. Students are given the opportunity to develop/correct their work.
