Thank you for all your support throughout this term. We have been impressed by how well our students have behaved in terms of following the Covid-19 guidance and doing their lateral flow tests.


We hope our students and their families have a lovely Easter break and we look forward to seeing everyone again on Monday 19th April.



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• Easter Testing Arrangements

Students without symptoms should continue to test themselves twice a week at home during the Easter holidays using the Lateral Flow Device (LFD) home testing kits. Ideally this should be done every Monday and Thursday.

Anyone living in a household with someone who attends or works in a school and does not have symptoms can also access LFD home testing kits. These testing kits are available from community collection points listed in the following link: https://find-covid-19-rapid-test-sites.maps.test-and-trace.nhs.uk/ or by ordering for home delivery via https://www.gov.uk/order-coronavirus-rapid-lateral-flow-tests. We would encourage everyone without symptoms to test themselves twice a week.

Any student who develops symptoms of COVID-19 should be tested as soon as possible with a PCR test, not an LFD test. An appointment for a PCR test can be booked via the following link https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test-or-by-calling-119.

Easter Test and Trace Arrangements

Parents/guardians should continue to notify the school if their child develops symptoms of COVID-19, is tested asymptomatically (tested when they have not got symptoms) with a PCR or tests positive after a home LFD test in the final week before the Easter break using the following number 07784 672439.

Notifying the school if your child develops COVID-19 symptoms after the school closes for Easter

Notify the school if:

- Your child develops symptoms, is asymptomatically tested (tested when they do not have symptoms) with a PCR or tests positive after a home LFD test up to and including the 3
 April 2021 and;
- Your child was in school in the 2 days prior to the symptom on-set (or test if they have been tested but do not have symptoms)

You do not need to notify the school if:

• Your child has not been in school in the 2 days prior to the symptom on-set (or test if they have been tested but do not have symptoms)

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 Your child develops symptoms or is asymptomatically tested (tested when they don't have symptoms) from 4 April 2021

The national test and trace service will contact you to complete the contact tracing.

Returning to school after Easter

The school does not need to be notified if your child is required to self-isolate during the Easter holidays. If your child is required to isolate after the 18 April 2021 and will not be in school on the 19 April 2021 please call 0151 355 2373 (Attendance) by the 18 April 2021 outlining the reason why they are isolating and the date they will return. We will then review these emails when we re-open on the 19 April 2021.

Test and trace arrangements when the school re-opens after Easter

From the 19 April 2021 onwards the normal test and trace procedures will apply, and parents should contact the school to notify us if their child develops symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive after completing a home LFD testing kit using the following number 0151 355 2373.

In the summer 2020, research by the National Literacy Trust found that only 26% of under-18's spent time reading each day – <u>the lowest daily level recorded since the charity first surveyed children's reading habits in 2005</u>.
