"Be still and know that I am God"






Inspirational Lecture for EPCHs Physics student's

Last Friday Year 13 and Year 12 Physics students were given a lecture by Professor Phil Allport from Birmingham University where he lectures on Particle Physics and is also a key member of the Physics team within CERN and chairs the European Committee for Future Accelerator Detectors Panels on the ATLAS Detector at CERN. The lecture lasted 40 minutes and covered various topics: A' Level Particle physics, the discovery of the Higgs Boson and CERN both past and present and beyond the future upgrade to CERN. When the lecture was over Phil opened the floor to a question-and-answer session in which several students engaged asking fundamental questions about particle physics and the concepts that surround Particle Physics.

I would like to thank Phil for giving up his time to give the lecture at EPCH's and thank the students for their engagement during the lecture.

Please encourage your child to do as much as they can, especially during these 2 days.


