Geography

Year/Term	Unit	Intent
September to November	Geographical Skills and Fantastic Places	In this topic, Year 7 students will develop fundamental geographical skills such as map reading, interpreting geographical data, and using compass directions. They will also explore the concept of "Fantastic Places," examining unique and awe-inspiring locations around the world, understanding their significance, and appreciating the diversity of landscapes on our planet.
November to January	Physical Geography of the UK	During this unit, Year 7 students will delve into the physical geography of the United Kingdom.
